

Youth Outreach (YO!)


Each year since 1989 Hale Kipa, in collaboration with Waikiki Health, service hundreds of runaway, homeless, and street identified youth and young adults up to the age of twenty-two. The YO! staff develop relationships by effectively engaging a range of youth / young adults with differing ages, ethnicities, sexual orientations, and cultures in a sensitive and respectful manner.

YO! provides street outreach, drop-in services, case management, and health and medical services to youth on a referral or walk-in basis. Youth and young adults are also introduced to a range of services that are critical to transitioning from the streets into a more stable environment.

By taking the services to the streets and providing a "youth friendly" drop-in center, YO! is able to engage youth that other programs may not reach.


